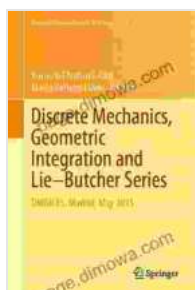

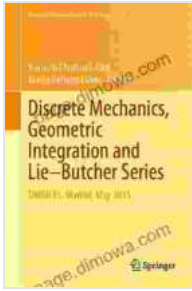
## **Visa Information**

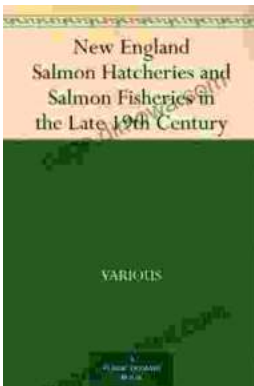

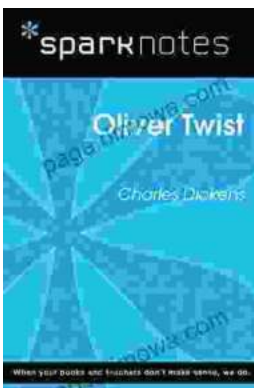
