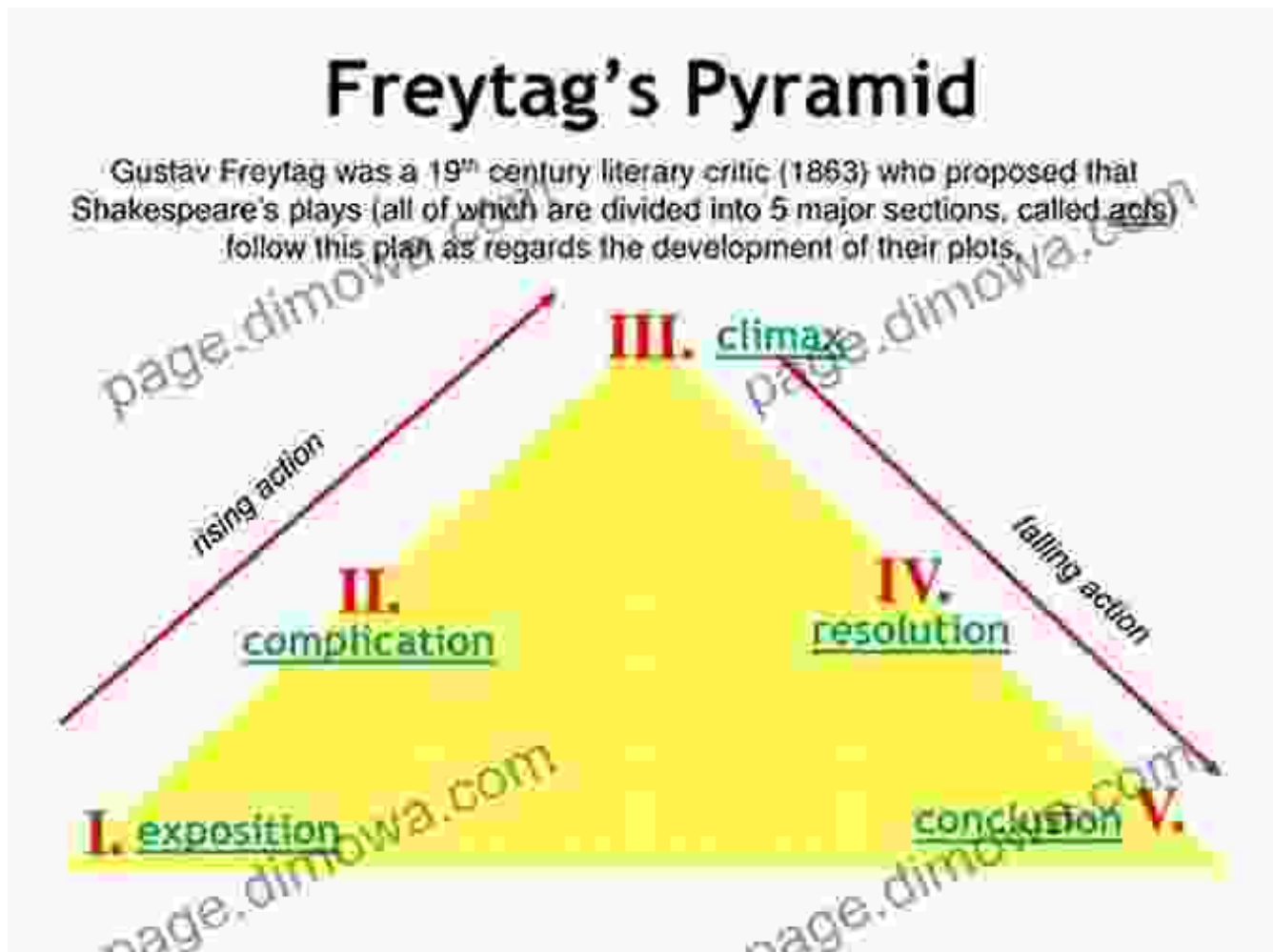

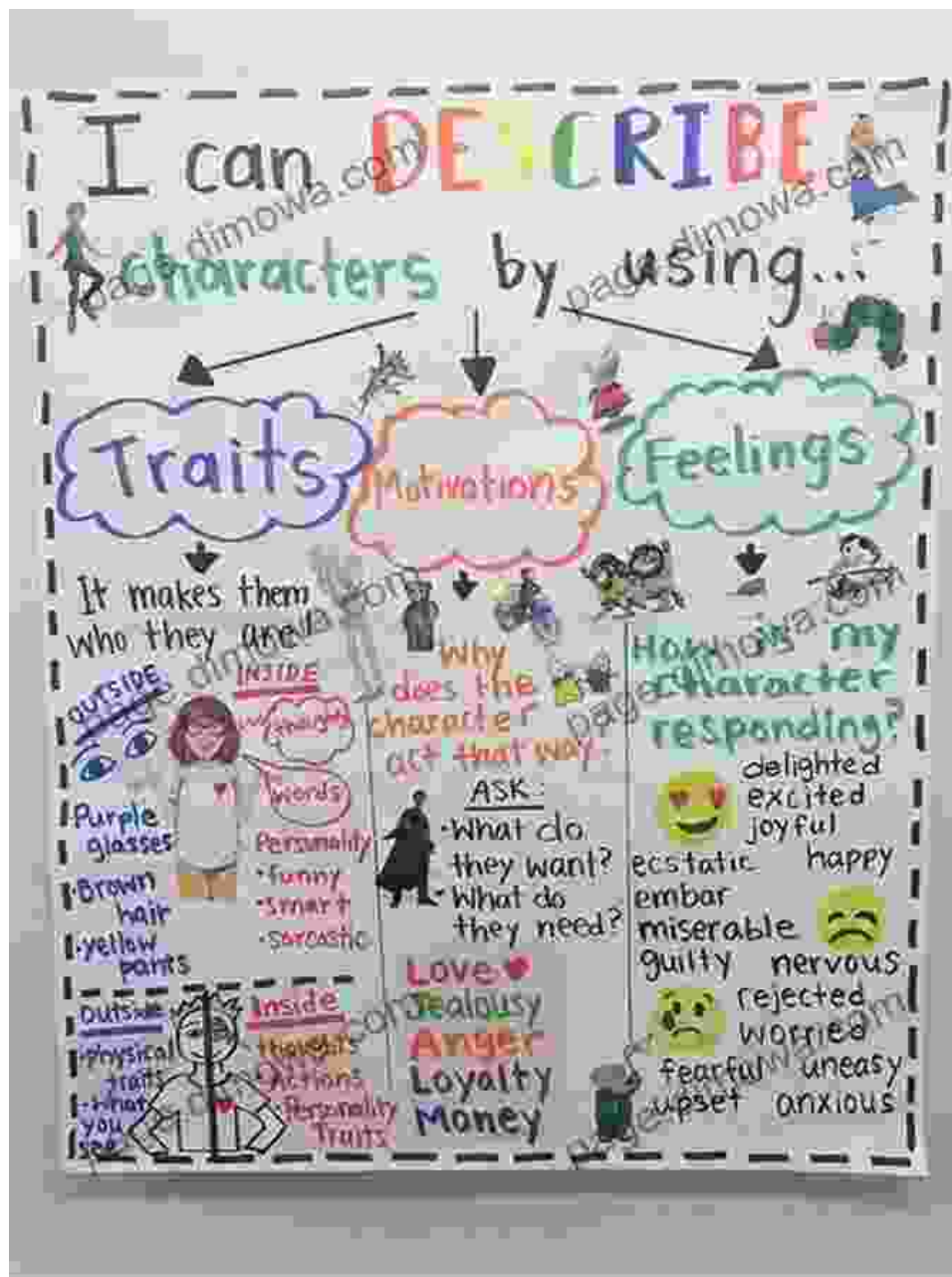

Riley turns from the mirror and approaches.

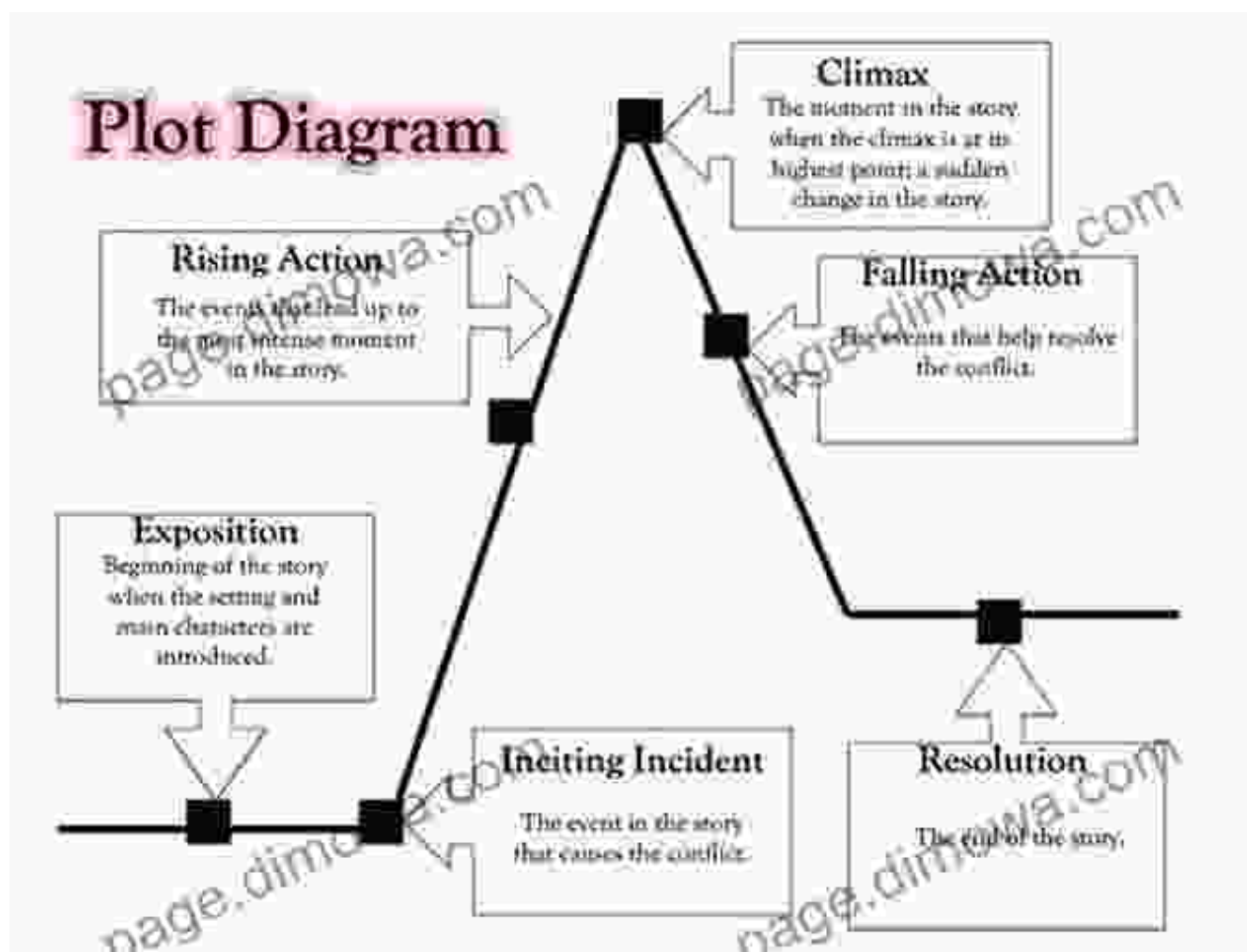
